The school was set up in the year 1989 by the Congregation of the Sisters of Nazareth. The main goal of our school is to impart education, to keep the students abreast of time and to become a worthwhile human being.

The school reopened on 1st June with the blessings of Rev.Fr. Rony Paul Kavil, with 1200 students, 55 staff members and 33 non teaching staff. New principal, Sr. Lisieux CSN and Manager Sr. Sneha CSN were introduced by our Educational Councillor Dr.Sr.Alphonse CSN.

Result

The fruitage was 100% in class X. 34 Students secured A1 in all subjects. The excellent performance of this sort by our students, acts as a reward to our teachers' toil and as an inspirational one for the next batch by X standard.

School Election

Tapping of Talents

We believe that every child is a bundle of talents and to unwrap this we conduct arts festival, sports meet, notice board, quiz, spelling competitions in connection with important days. They are grouped under four different clubs & four different groups to give them the vigour to compete and excel. Arts, Science, Maths and Service clubs

were officially inaugurated by the Principal. Children put forth a skit to highlight the importance of each club. To aid holistic development of a child, We merge scholastic and co-scholastic areas in the course of study. They get classes for keyboard, karate, basketball, abacus, craft and dance. Our children are given to celebrate important days like Chandrayan Day, Environmental Day, keralapiravi, reading week and they do come out with wonderful ideas and thoughts.

We do know that children are prone to make mistakes and find it difficult to manage competitions at times. To help them emotionally and to improve their emotional quotient, counseling sessions are given to them by our own sisters who are trained for the same.

NURTURING OF TEACHERS

Classes are given to teachers to polish their talents and to learn new techniques of teaching. Teachers attend training classes conducted by Sahodaya and CBSE. These classes give them a good exposure to the new methods of teaching.

Achievements of the Year

I am gratified to place it before you that our school was placed in the 1st position under UP section, in Malappuram Central sahodaya district kalotsav. We bagged overall 5th position among 79 schools that competed. Our students have shown their brilliance even at the state level. Varada M of class X got the 3rd place in English essay writing under category IV. Liya Mariyam of class VII got the 2nd place in English Essay writing under category II. Our girls were placed 3rd in group dance under category III.

District Sports meet

Malappuram Central Sahodaya Athletic championship was held at university ground on 3rd and 4th of December. 30 of our students participated. They bagged 5 Gold Medals, and 5 Silver Medals. We were placed 3rd in mini kiddies Boys under 10 and girls under 14. Sriram Gopinath of 8th standard fetched the championship under 14 boys.

Our children participated in the malappuram central sahodaya Badminton Championship. I am elated to announce that our girls bagged overall II under 10 and overall III under 14.
